1. The basic spot is the previous spot unless Rule 8-5-2c applies for a foul by A or B when the run ends behind the line of scrimmage where there is no change of possession.

True

2. Effective with the 2024 season, the entire body of the number shall be a single solid color that clearly contrasts with the body color of the jersey.

True

3. The horse-collar foul is enforced as a live-ball foul.

True

4. By state association adoption, use of instant replay is allowed only for postseason games.

True

5. The field of play is the area within sidelines and the goal lines.

True

6. The free-blocking zone disintegrates and the exception for an offensive lineman to block in the back is not to continue after the ball has left the zone.

True

7. When R1 gains possession of a free kick, blocking below the waist by teammates is legal.

8. A down ends when the live ball becomes dead.

True

9. If there is a double foul during the last timed down of a period, the period is automatically extended.

10. Any receiver may signal for a fair catch while any legal kick is in flight.

53. During a punt return, R32 commits an illegal blindside block at R's 37-yard line. The returner runs out of bounds at R's 39-yard line. Which spot is the foul enforced from?

B. The spot of the foul

54. A has first and 10 on B's 28-yard line. A13 rolls out toward the right sideline and throws a pass from B's 37-yard line that crosses the neutral zone. There are no eligible receivers in the area. The passer has committed a foul for intentional grounding.

55. A has first and 10 on B's 44-yard line. The A linemen on the right side are still moving into a three-point stance as A6 starts in motion. After multiple handoffs and a backward pass, A8 throws a pass to A85 who catches the ball for a touchdown. B18 interfered with A85 on B's 2-yard line prior to the pass being caught. What is the final result following any potential penalty enforcement?
